



Hitters Pickleball Re-Opening Overview

Arrival

We would like to draw attention to the top three most important protocols

- Please make sure you do not have symptoms of COVID-19 or flu, including but not limited to, breathing difficulties, cough or fever, before entering the club.
- Please stay home if you have been in contact with any known person with COVID-19 within the past 14 days and/or you may have any compromised immunity.
- Please be certain that hands are thoroughly washed and sanitized before arrival.

At the Club

- Only players with reservations or Open Play players are permitted in the facility, no spectators.
- Our upstairs locker rooms and lounge area will be temporarily closed.
- Towel service will be temporarily suspended. Members are encouraged to bring clean towels.
- Your Pickleball experience can be virtually touch free with the use of Punch Cards.
- Our facility will be touch free from entrance to your court.
- Doubles and singles will be permitted.

On-court Pickleball Guidelines from USAPA

- Clean and wipe down your paddles and water bottles. Do not share paddles or any other equipment or clothing.
- Players should keep a minimum of 6 feet social distancing with opponents and partners at all times.
- Bring a full personal use water bottle(s).
- Bring tissues or a handkerchief for contained sneezing and coughing or consider wearing a mask.
- Consider wearing face mask.
- Use new pickleballs and a new grip or fresh tape on your paddle handle if possible.
- Coordinate with your play group so that each person serves with a different color ball. If multiple colors are not an option, use a sharpie and prominently mark personal pickleballs with your initials.
- Please exit the court as soon as play is completed and within your reservation time frame and please promptly exit the club after play.
- Use hand sanitizer immediately after your match is over.

Facility Precautions

- Our facility has been completely sanitized and deep cleaned.
- We are strictly adhering to the Wisconsin Guidance on Preparing Workplaces for COVID-19.
- Our staff has been trained on all COVID-19 facility protocols.
- The facility will be sanitized on a scheduled regular basis.
